For many months parents, teachers, the Parent Teacher Association (PTA) and the Athletic Booster Club have been informing the school district headquarters personnel and Patterson Mill principal and school officials (assistant principals, athletic directors, coaches) about the deficiencies in the design or completion status of the Patterson Mill school facilities for physical education, community recreation and athletics. Members of the Emmorton Recreation Association of the Harford County Parks and Recreation Department have also voiced their concerns to the parents, Booster Club and teachers/coaches of Patterson Mill about the incomplete, poorly constructed and/or poorly designed facilities.

Dates provided indicate the time notice was given to officials of the school district. Information and general recommendations are provided about what needs to be improved/completed.

In either case, the baseball field and softball fields would not be ready for play this week without the efforts of the Emmorton Rec Council and concerned parents. Note: the girl's softball was not ready for the first game in 2008.
- What is status of the approximately 1.707 MILLION Dollars left in the capital budget for PMHS/MS which has been reported is still available for use? School Board transferred \$140,000 out of the account and according to Mr. Licata transferred back \$100,000.
